

Theodore McAlindon - Biography

Theodore McAlindon is a British-Irish Dramatic Bass, originally from Leeds. Growing up he was a member of the Opera North Youth Company and the Ely Cathedral Choir in Cambridgeshire. Having moved to London in 2018, he began studying under Professor Mark Wildman where he tailored much of his repertoire to the genres of German Lieder, English Art Song and Russian Songs, as well as arias from the Basso Profondo repertoire. Throughout the years he was given the opportunity to take on roles such as Masetto, Leporello, Bottom and Superintendent Budd, alongside premiering a number of Contemporary operatic works with Tete-a-Tete Opera Company. Currently studying on the Master of Arts programme at the Royal Academy, he is preparing for external engagements and competitions around the UK, as well as auditioning for Young Artist Programmes across Europe and the United States.
